

Statutory Factors In Regard To Alimony
Florida Statutes §61.08(2)

- (a) The standard of living established during the marriage.

- (b) The duration of the marriage.

- (c) The age and physical and emotional condition of each party.

- (d) The financial resources of each party.

- (e) When applicable, the time necessary for either party to acquire sufficient education or training to enable such party to find appropriate employment.

- (f) The contribution of each party to the marriage, including, but not limited to, services rendered in homemaking, childcare, education, and career building of the other party.

- (g) All sources of income available to either party.

- (h) Any other factor necessary to do equity and justice between the parties.
